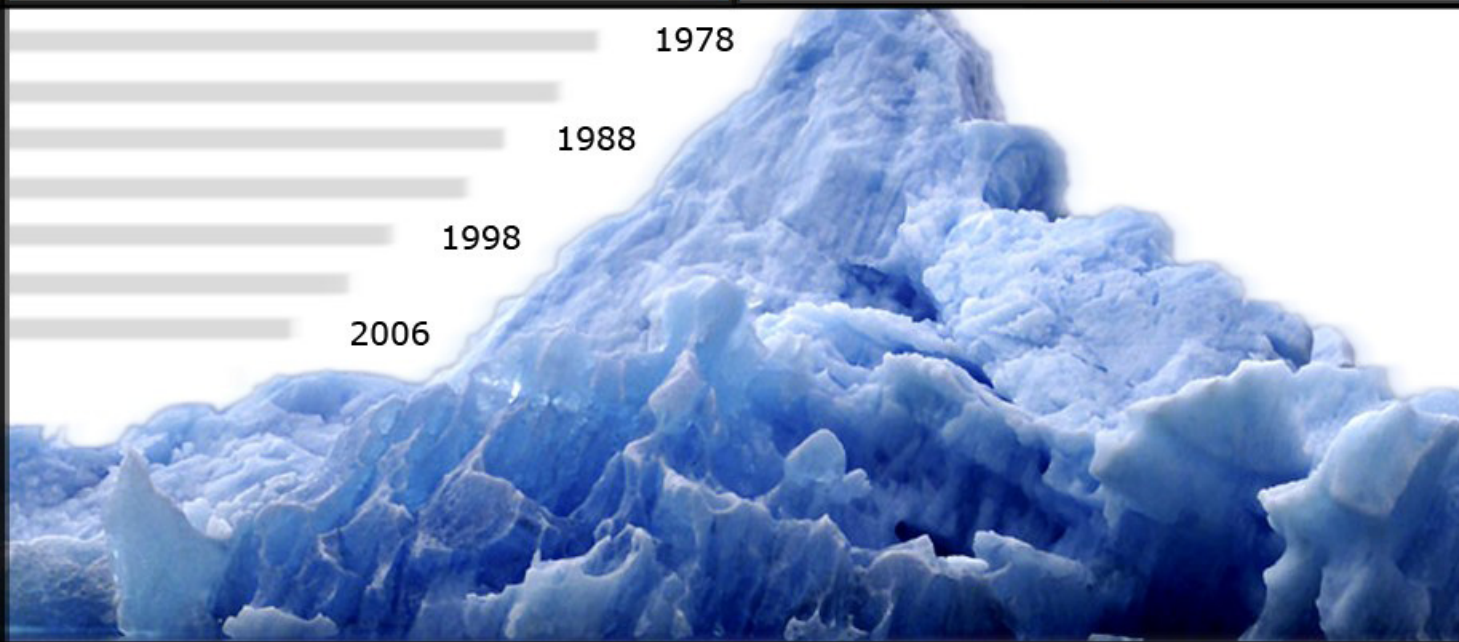


Since 1978, Arctic sea ice has shrunk by 9% per decade
